CLUBHOUSE DRESS CODE

Business Casual – Jacket and tie optional, no jeans, no shorts. “T” or collarless shirts are not acceptable, short or long sleeved shirts for men require collars. No sneakers.

Casual – Casual attire includes jeans (no rips or holes), shorts (must be walking length shorts not short-shorts), sneakers, and in the bar area only, tennis attire dress.

Hats – hats should not be worn in the bar or dining room during any meal service.

Tennis Attire – Tennis attire is never permitted in the dining room or living room. Tennis attire is permitted in the bar area only. However, after 6:00 PM warm up jackets and pants are required over tennis attire. Please change to dry tennis attire.
